

Minutes of the Electoral Board of the City of Waynesboro

March 22, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Elizabeth Bouldin-Clopton at 4:15 PM. The purpose of the called meeting was to staff the June Dual Primary Election, decide on ballot order and set training dates for officers of Election.

A list of Officers of Election and assignment of Polling Places is attached to the minutes. It was decided that ballots for each party should equal fifty percent of total registered voters. This is based on turnout of similar Gubernatorial dual primary elections. Discussion about the polling place for Ward A followed with the decision that if we cannot use 2<sup>nd</sup> Presbyterian, we will use the City Building as an emergency backup. We have not yet heard from the church as to whether they will allow its use for the Primary. The Salvation Army refused our request to use their facility because of date conflicts with sign-ups for Christmas giving. This is disappointing as their facility would be a perfect solution. Mary Alice will follow up with Basic Methodist to see if they might allow use of their fellowship hall as a permanent voting location.

Training for Officials for the June Primary will be May 31<sup>st</sup> for Wards A and B and June 1<sup>st</sup> for Wards C and D.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:15 PM.
