



Fireworks



Law



- In Waynesboro, Virginia, any fireworks that explode, travel laterally, rise into the air, or fire projectiles into the air including firecrackers, sky rockets, torpedoes and bottle rockets are prohibited by the Virginia Statewide Fire Prevention Code.
- A permit is required for the sale of all fireworks. These permits can be obtained through the Fire Marshal's office.
- Since even the possession of unapproved fireworks is prohibited in the City of Waynesboro, such fireworks will be confiscated, and the person possessing them can be charged with a Class I misdemeanor. This carries a maximum penalty of \$2500 fine and/or one year in jail
